



NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER-MAY 4, 2023

The National Day of Prayer is an annual observance held on the first Thursday of May, inviting people of all faiths to pray for the nation. It was created in 1952 by a joint resolution of the United States Congress, and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. The National Day of Prayer is a vital part of our heritage. Since the first call to prayer in 1775, when the Continental Congress asked the colonies to pray for wisdom in forming a nation, the call to prayer has continued through our history, including President Lincoln's proclamation of a day of *"humiliation, fasting, and prayer"* in 1863. In 1952, a joint resolution by Congress, signed by President Truman, declared an annual national day of prayer. In 1988, the law was amended and signed by President Reagan, permanently setting the day as the first Thursday of every May. Each year, the president signs a proclamation, encouraging all Americans to pray on this day. Last year, all 50 state governors plus the governors of several U.S. territories signed similar proclamations.

You may have noticed our Local 2209 Chaplaincy Committee walking the shop floor this week. We do this as a reminder that members of the committee work in conjunction with EAP representatives to assist all members through hard times. I would personally like to thank the Chaplaincy Committee for all of their continued support of this membership. I am asking all of you to please, thank them for their time, patience and guidance the next time you see them.
