NOVEMBER CHAPTER MEETING November 19th 2025, 10:00am

There is no scheduled speaker for our November Chapter meeting. We will have regular order of business, followed by our luncheon.

THERE WILL NOT BE A BENEFIT REP AT THE UNION HALL ON 11/26/25

Shawn Fain was at our Retiree meeting on October 15th, 2025, below are highlights

- Retirees are the life blood of the UAW, and they will continue to add benefits for Retirees.
- Communication strategy along with being vocal, now shows Americas are 75% with support for the UAW- they realize the working class has been left behind in this country for decades.
- Over the last 30 years 65 plants have been lost by the Big 3 and that is with UAW working with companies and they still close plants. Companies care only for profits for shareholders, not us.
- The days of giving free political endorsements are done -each party now needs to earn our endorsement. Examples were given.
- UAW has 4 core values-wages, health care, retirement security and getting time back-meaning balance of work and life schedules. Not having to work 7 days a week
- Since NAFTA in 1994 we have lost 90,000 facilities in the US. The UAW is in favor of targeted tariffs, not a flat percentage or widespread tariffs.
- With this last contract negotiation, the contract time has changed from September to May 1st based on the fact it's more advantageous to strike when production is high, not in September when sales tend to decrease. This is now called May Day for future contracts. With Shawn, if an agreement is not reached by May 1st (May Day)-action will be taken by the UAW- example This last contact was the stand-up strike.
- In the last 2 years the UAW has organized 50 new plants and 75,000 new members.
- If Tier 2 employees retire, even with 30 years they're not considered Retirees, they are considered Quit.
- We are a dying breed, and our voice needs to be heard, please vote when ballots are sent to us for next year's International Elections- make our voice heard.
