NEW MEDICAL ID CARDS UNITED HEALTHCARE MA, BLUE CROSS MA AND BLUE CROSS ECP

Members currently enrolled in United Health Care Medicare Advantage plan, Blue Cross Medicare Advantage plan and the Blue Cross Enhanced Care PPO (ECP) plan will receive new Medical ID cards in mid-December 2025. Be sure to use the new medical ID card for all medical services after January 1, 2026.

Do Not throw your OTC or WEX cards away at the end of the year, as money will be added to your current cards you currently have.


JUST FOR LAUGHS
