• SAP 85 POINT APPLICATION WITHDRAWAL PERIOD

Discussions between the Corporation and the UAW-GM Vice-Presidents office continue concerning the separation dates given for the SAP. Employees may withdraw their SAP application through Workday through 11:59pm EST on August 10, 2026. Based on your given separation date, that is the last day you can withdraw from the SAP program if that date doesn't work for you.

• DEPENDANT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM REMINDER

As the fall semester will be starting soon the UAW-GM Dependent Scholarship Program for member's children entering/continuing college will be in full swing! Eligible **active** members can receive up to \$1600 annually toward the cost of dependent post-secondary education or training. Most Indiana Universities will start their fall semesters in August and as per the guidelines the window for submissions for the UAW-GM Scholarship Program for Dependent Children begins 30 days prior to the fall term start date. **Applications made after your student's semester start date will not be accepted.**

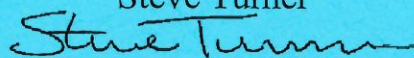
