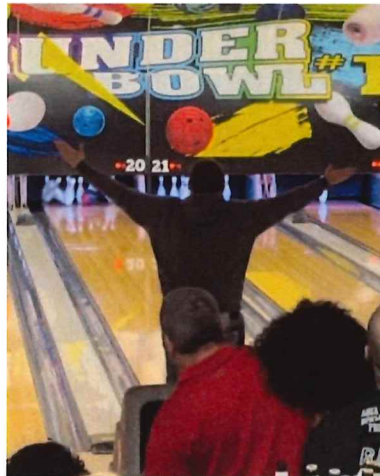


## ***UAW REGIONAL BOWLING TOURNAMENT***

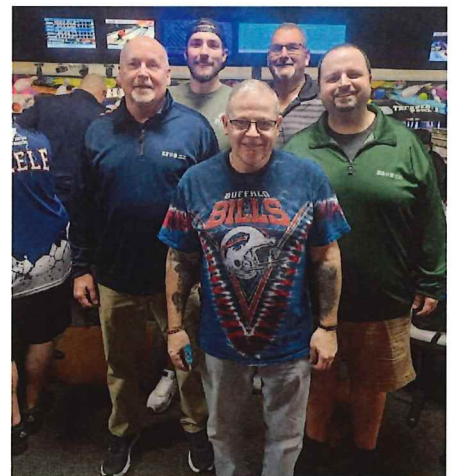

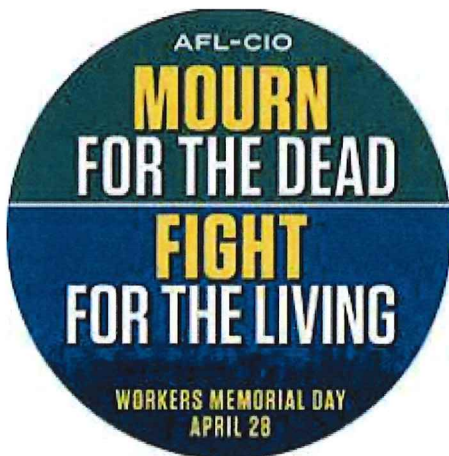
