Per the UAW-RWDSU agreement, UAW Local 2209 employees will not be working.

Per membership action at the February 2024 union meeting, and the rejection of the Proposed Bylaw Amendment of Article 11, Section 6 at the February 2024 meeting, we will not be assisting with unemployment at the union hall next week. Per the 'Message from Travis' "employees scheduled during that week varies from shop to shop, based upon workload"

Unlike in the past, I am unable to request anyone for union leave under paragraph 109 in the UAW-GM Collective Bargaining Agreement due to lack of available hours.

Proposed Bylaw Amendment


Article 11, Section 6

The Local Union shall pay an officer or member lost time only when that officer or member is performing necessary duties for, or on behalf of, the Local Union during a time for which they would otherwise receive pay from the employer, pursuant to Article 5. The amount of lost time should never exceed the amount which the Local Union officer or member would otherwise receive from the employer for the same period of time for which they are being compensated by the Local Union.

In the event the company does not provide proper documentation for the officer or member's lost time, an officer or member shall be entitled to up to 12 hours of wages per day at the same hourly rate as their employer, pursuant to Article 5.

Lost time must be limited to the minimum time necessary to perform Union business. All lost time shall be reported to the membership as part of the Financial Report, by the Financial Secretary, at the regular meeting.


RALLY TO SUPPORT DREYER'S ICE CREAM WORKERS
