○ MASK EXCHANGE OPTIONS

As part of the new GM safety protocol it is important to wear a clean, GM supplied mask daily. The current protocol of wearing your mask from the previous day back into the plant and exchanging it for a clean one has come with some understandable concerns. We did discuss these concerns with Mary Barra and her staff while they were in the plant.

In order to address the concern, the company is offering the following options when entering the facility on an individual basis. Pick the one that works best for you:

- Continue to utilize the current process
- Wear a personal mask into the facility until you exchange it with the GM supplied mask at the entry point (please note that any personal mask worn into the facility cannot be worn past the entry point in any manner)
- Obtain a one-time extra mask from your supervisor to facilitate the following process for the next day and beyond:
 - Wear the clean mask into the facility
 - Follow the hand sanitizing protocol
 - At the mask stations-let us know that you have a clean mask on and obtain a clean mask for the following day-no need to perform exchange
 - It is your responsibility to properly protect this mask

*****At the end of the day please remember to keep your mask on until you exit the turnstiles.**

Thank you for raising the concern so that we can address it. Ultimately our goal is to protect all of our team members the entire time you are in the facility. We are all learning as we go and are committed to listening to suggestions. The health and safety of our team members is important to us, and we are committed to providing you with what you need to remain safe at work. Please continue to take care of yourselves and in turn protect your coworkers by following all established procedures.
