• MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY QUALIFYING DAYS

As a reminder in accordance with the provisions of Document 8 of the UAW/GM National Agreement the use of VR hours will not be permitted, unless excused in advance, on holiday qualifying days or the last scheduled workday in the week preceding a Monday holiday.

Therefore, **Friday, May 24, 2024, is a Black Out Day and Tuesday, May 28, 2024, is both a Black Out and Qualifying Day.** Employees not previously approved to be off on these days cannot cover their absence with VR and are subject to the next step in the Attendance Improvement Process. The Shop Committee would like to wish everyone a safe and enjoyable 3-day weekend.

• SAP UPDATE

At 10am today we received an update on the SAP numbers. Corporate wide there are 1412 Production and 142 Skilled Trades approved for the SAP. We were also told that there will be some retroactive retirements for January, February and March who will also be approved for the SAP, details to follow. We finally received the list of those approved locally, all of Production **who applied and are eligible** for the SAP were approved. There were also 7 Skilled Trades approved. Those approved will be contacted by the Corporation with their retirement date.

• BIQ 4 CERTIFICATION-CELEBRATION

On May 9th Fort Wayne Assembly was officially informed that we had passed the BIQ 4 audit in February and now are a certified BIQ 4 plant. In recognition of our members hard work in achieving this status the parties are jointly working on a celebratory event, which will occur after the 3-week downtime. Details are forthcoming.

• COLA INCREASE

After the recent calculation of the 3-month CPI-W average for Feb-March-April, the COLA float has increased from \$.12 to \$.55. This increase will be applied to the first full pay period in June.
